Children's charity SAFE@LAST to benefit from Homeflair event

SAFE@LAST provides services for the 1 in 9 children in South Yorkshire who run away from home or care. SAFE@LAST provides preventative work, a 24 hour helpline (0800 335 SAFE), a MISPER (Missing Persons) Scheme and an emergency refuge for young people who are 16 and under. SAFE@LAST receives very little statutory income and the majority of its services are reliant on the generosity of charitable trusts and individuals.

The event held at Homeflair which sells garden, kitchen, bathroom and furniture will be a chance for visitors to see the fabulous items for sale while supporting a worthwhile cause.

Entertainment at the event will include demonstrations of how to make the perfect scones and hanging baskets with the final items auctioned off for charity. Other events taking place will include a charity auction and Body Shop stall with support on how to use all their products. To keep the kids entertained there will be a hook a duck game and face painters.

Entry to the event is free so come along for some fun and shopping while supporting SAFE@LAST.
